

Plug-in Upgrade Instructions August 2010 Release

Plug-ins affected: All versions

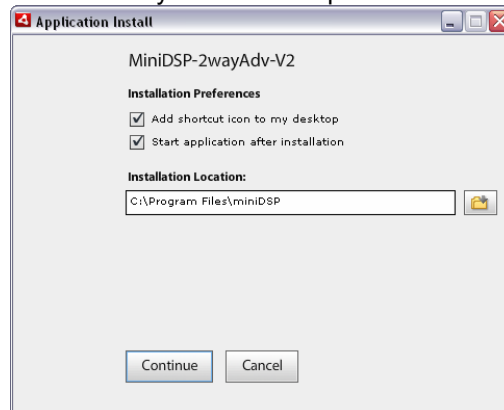
Log of changes:

- Mac OS X support for Intel Core Duo machines
- Upgrade of behind the scenes synchronization method for better reliability
- Minor UI improvements

Note: This version does not include any modification of the DSP structure compared to the previous release. In other words, all previous configurations will be fully compatible.

Windows Platform - Step by Step instructions

- 1) Before proceeding to the installation, we recommend you to first un-install your older version. To make sure that settings of your previous configuration are carried over, remember to save your old configuration as instructed in the miniDSP user manual, in the system settings tab -> Save as a .xml your settings. You can now un-install your old plug-in from Windows's control panel -> Add/Remove programs
- 2) Download the new plug-in from the **User Menu** of the MiniDSP website. Clicking on **User Downloads** will bring up a page containing the purchased plug-ins.
- 3) If your machine isn't connected to Internet at the time of installation, make sure to install Adobe Air 2.0 from the Adobe website.
- 4) In the downloaded zip file, the installation files are divided depending your OS. For Windows machines, open the .exe install program in the "Windows folder". The following dialog box appears to warn you of a new installation and let you select the path of installation.



- 5) The software automatically starts in offline mode as usual.

Note: Starting from this version, your miniDSP settings.xml configuration files will be saved under MyDocuments. To load an older configuration file, go to System Settings in miniDSP plug-in and click the "Load" button to browse to the location of the old configuration file saved in step 1.

- 6) Once the plug-in correctly configured, click on Synchronize to load your configuration. At the prompt, select "Upgrade and Synchronize" to correctly configure your board.

You're now good to go! Have fun!



MAC Platform - Step by Step instructions

- 1) Since this set of plug-in is the first Mac compatible release, nothing to un-install.
- 2) Download the new plug-in from the **User Menu** of the MiniDSP website. Clicking on **User Downloads** will bring up a page containing the purchased plug-ins.
- 3) If your machine isn't connected to Internet at the time of installation, make sure to install Adobe Air 2.0 from the Adobe website.
- 4) Double-click the .DMG file located in the Mac folder of the .Zip file you just downloaded. Another new icon with a name similar to the .DMG file will appear on your desktop.
- 5) If a new Finder window doesn't automatically appear, double click on the new icon that has appeared on your desktop. Locate your application's icon within this new Finder window. Drag and drop it into your "Applications" directory.

You're now good to go! Have fun!
